





- Experimental estimation of insularity costs
- Analysis of Island-specific factors that impact on islands
- Study visits and interviews
- Case studies
- Capacity building seminars for peer-learning
- Reports with assessment of strategies policies and multi-level governance
- Policy recommendations
- Policy action plan
- Policy toolkit
- Pilot policy implementation



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
