The event is the third in a new event series, called **Technical Regional Forums** (**TRF**), designed to provide space for exchange, knowledge sharing, and networking. The TRF will feature panels, hands-on workshops, and a site visit, gathering about 120 participants to exchange on the specific challenges of attracting and developing skills in peripheral and island communities, approaches to develop skilled labour, showcase examples from JTF regions close to the Baltic Sea and other peripheral regions.

**Note on travel:** We recommend arranging your travel on March 11th and return in the afternoon of March 13th. Visby has an <u>airport</u>, that is being served from Stockholm six to seven times per day. The flight between Stockholm and Visby takes about 45 minutes. Alternatively, one can take the <u>ferry</u> from Nynäshamn, Stockholm (leaving twice a day) or Oskarshamn, Småland (once a day). The ferry trip between Visby and Swedish mainland takes approximately 3 hours and 15 minutes.
